Document Size: A4.

Margins: top, bottom, left, right -2 cm.

Author Information Structure:

- Information about the author:
 - o First and last name;
 - o Name of the higher education institution/scientific institution/organization;
 - o E-mail;
- Information about the scientific supervisor (if the participants are higher education students):
 - o Last name and initials;
 - o Scientific degree, academic title;
 - o Name of the higher education institution/scientific institution/organization.

Formatting:

- Alignment: right-aligned on the page;
- Line spacing: single (1.0);
- Font size: 14 pt;
- Typeface: Calibri.

Title Formatting

- One line after the title;
- Alignment: centered on the page;
- Text formatting: all capital letters, no period;
- Line spacing: single (1.0);
- Font size: 18 pt;
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Main Text Formatting

- One line after the title;
- Alignment: justified across the page;
- Line spacing: 1.15;
- Font size: 14 pt;
- Typeface: Calibri.
